Entrants & alternates must be present at this drawing to guarantee their position in the test. The first tracks will run shortly after the draw.

DIRECTIONS: South on N. Mountain Rd toward ME-32. Turn left onto ME-32S. In 1.5 miles turn left onto ME-126E/ME-32S. Stay on ME 32S. Go approx. 9.5 miles and turn left onto US Route 1 North. In approx. 6.4 miles, turn left onto ME-90E. In approx. 0.4 miles, destination is on the right.

ENTRY FEES: TD \$75.00 and TDX \$125.00 (incl. \$0.50 AKC recording and \$3.00 service fee). No entry fees will be refunded except for an entrant that pulls before the closing date; or an entrant and/or alternate that does not participate when another alternate is present to replace him prior to the test draw. **Make checks payable to MCKC and mail with entry fee & certification (for TD) to: Carol Tichy, 998 Overlock Hill Rd., Union, ME 04862.**

ENTRIES: Entries will not be accepted without fees. Faxed, telephone E-mail and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC form and copies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. Owners are responsible for errors in completing entry forms & no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a fee to each returned check. **If entering more than one dog, please send a separate check for each entry.**

No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery.

CLOSING DATE: Entries for the test close Thursday, April 18, 2019 at 4 pm, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries.

TD CERTIFICATION: With each TD entry form for a licensed or member Tracking Test for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed an original written statement, dated within 24 months of the date of the Tracking Test, signed by a person who has been approved by the American Kennel Club to judge Tracking Tests, certifying that the dog is considered by him/her to be ready for such a test.

DRAWING OF ENTRIES FOR TD/TDX TEST: A drawing will be held at 4:00 pm, Thursday, April 18, 2019 at the Washington General Store, Washington, Maine to fill entry limits of 4 TD tracks and 4 TDX tracks. If the limit is not reached, the draw is optional. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received. When the limits have been drawn from all entries, the remaining entries shall be assigned to a position on alternate list(s) corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. Should the limits not be reached for the TD or TDX tests, tracks may be exchanged on a basis of two TD tracks equal to one TDX track. Following the draw, the test secretary will attempt to contact all entrants and advise them of the outcome within 48 hours. Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present, according to the order in which they were drawn shall assume the vacant position. Drawing is open to all interested persons.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may participate in this test. The test secretary and judges are to be notified prior to the drawing for running order the day of the test. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw will be held for these bitches.

#### DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE:

*Traveling North* on I-295 take the US-201 Exit 49 towards Gardiner, ME. Merge onto Brunswick Ave/US-201 towards Gardiner. Turn slight left onto Brunswick Ave/US-201 N. Continue to follow US-201 N. Stay straight to go onto Bridge St./ME-9/ME-126/ME-27. Turn left onto Windsor St./ME-226. Sun Sun restaurant is on corner. Go 5.5 miles and turn right onto Eastern Ave./Rte 17. Go approximately 8 miles on Rt 17 and take a slight right onto Rte 32 which is on the right after you pass Peaslee's Market and gas station. Stay on Route 32 for approx. 3.18 miles and make a left on North Mountain Road. There is a cemetery on the corner. A big red barn is right after the cemetery on the right. Continue straight ahead approx. 2 miles; at the fork in the road, bear left onto Jones Rd. Continue approx. ½ mile, North Star Dog Training School is on the right. Mailbox #252.

*Traveling South* on I-95 take the ME-3 Exit 113 toward Augusta/Belfast. Enter ME-3/Old Belgrade Rd. roundabout. Turn slight right onto ME-3, pass through 1 roundabout. Turn right to stay on ME=3. In approx. 1.73 miles turn right onto Riverside Drive/US-201S/ME-100. Continue to follow US 201S/ME-100. Enter next roundabout and take 3rd. exit onto ME-17/ME-9/Stone St. Go ½ mile and turn left onto Eastern Ave./ME-17. Go approx.12.62 miles on Route 17 and take a slight right onto Eastern Ave./Rte. 32 which is on the right after you pass Peaslee's Market and gas station. Stay on Route 32 for approx. 3.18 miles and make a left on North Mountain Road. There is a cemetery on the corner. The big red barn is right after the cemetery on the right. Continue straight ahead approx. 2 miles, at the fork in the road bear left onto Jones Rd. Continue approx. ½ mile, North Star Dog Training School is on the right. Mailbox #252.
